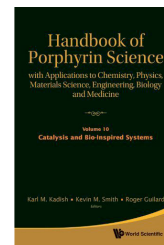


ICPP-7, Handbook and JPP "Grant" Program

Read your way to free ICPP-7 Registration!

Effective immediately, the *Society of Porphyrins and Phthalocyanines (SPP)* and *World Scientific Publishing Company (WSPC)* will be offering ICPP-7 participants grant vouchers of \$350 to assist them in attending the meeting.

How are the vouchers earned?

Purchase or successfully recommend purchase of following items **between August 1, 2011 and May 31, 2012**:

1. A new Institutional Library Subscription to JPP.

2. Any five-volume set *Handbook of Porphyrin Science*, at the web-listed price.

How many \$350 vouchers may be earned per participant?

There is no limit. For example, the purchase of four handbook sets (e.g. Volumes 1-20) and one new Institutional Library Subscription to JPP would generate a \$1,750 voucher.

How may the vouchers be used?

These may be used for any ICPP-7-related activity. Examples include registration of students, speakers and accompanying persons, banquet tickets, food packages, SPP dues, hotel payments and travel to or from the meeting.

What proof of purchase and/or proof of recommendation will be needed?

After payment, a second form (also good for Handbook purchases) will be provided, which needs to be completed and emailed to the SPP office in Houston at: icpp@uh.edu. In most cases, copies of a Purchase Order or credit card receipt will be sufficient.

How and when will the voucher(s) be distributed?

Vouchers for reimbursement of ICPP-7 registration-related expenses will be paid directly to the meeting, on behalf of the recipient, in a timely manner. Payments for reimbursement of travel or hotel expenses will be distributed by SPP at the meeting.

Who verifies that the purchase was actually made and who handles questions?

This will be done by SPP, most likely out of the Houston office (icpp@uh.edu).

Can vouchers be transferred to others?

This is not a problem and can be handled when completing the reimbursement form.

Summary of key points:

1. Only new Institutional JPP Subscriptions made after August 1, 2011 are eligible.
2. Only Handbook purchases made after August 1, 2011 are eligible.
3. All Handbook purchases must be made at the web-listed prices.
